GUIDELINES FOR PRESENTER

Abstract should be written in English using the template provided in MS Word for Windows template, formatted in Arial font, size 12 pt., with single line spacing.

Each submission must contain a concise and informative title, the full names and affiliations of all authors (surname in uppercase and presenter's surname is underlined), the email address of the corresponding or presenting author, and an abstract text not exceeding 250 words.

The abstract itself should be structured to include the background, problem statement, main objectives, methodology, key findings, and significance. It is critical to verify all details, as abstracts will be included in the symposium's official Programme and Abstract Book with minimal editing.

Abstract Submission Guidelines:

1. Abstract should be submitted electronically via the conference website ONLY.
2. Each presenter may submit one abstract.
3. Abstract must be submitted in both Microsoft Word (.doc/ .docx) and PDF (.pdf) formats.
4. Abstract should be thoroughly checked for spelling and grammar and ensure accuracy of scientific content before submission. Any request for amendment will not be entertained.
5. Please submit your abstract via our online system.

Mode of Presentation:

Abstract submitters may choose their preferred mode of presentation upon abstract submission. However, the final decision lies with the Scientific Committee. All abstracts will be reviewed and assigned to an appropriate theme/ session.

Oral Presentation

- Total of 15 minutes will be allocated for Oral Presentation, with 10 minutes of presentation + 5 minutes of Question and Answer session.
- Presenters must prepare presentation slides in MS Power Point format (.ppt or .pptx) with on-screen show 16:9 (landscape).
- Please submit your PowerPoint slides to the conference secretariat. Presenter must present onsite during the conference.

Poster Presentation

- Presenters are required to submit physical (printed) poster in the event day upon registration.
- The poster size shall be A0 (84.1 cm x 118.9 cm) in format and portrait in orientation.

Consent, Permission and Copyright

Submitters must conform to the following:

1. To accept responsibility for the accuracy of the submitted abstract understand that amendment is not allowed once it is submitted information provided will be published exactly as submitted
2. All co-authors are aware of and give consent to the content of the abstract data presented before it is submitted. The submitter accepts responsibility as the contact person for all correspondence about the abstract and to share information with all authors about its status.
3. Submission of abstracts implies the author's agreement to publish the abstract in all APGN2026 Symposium publications including the website, i.e. submitters are responsible to secure any copyright/permissions clearance required relating to any previous presentations, equipment or other material for inclusion in the APGN2026 Symposium publications.
4. Submitters are responsible to obtain permission from any relevant regulatory authority and obtain consent where appropriate.
5. Submitters are responsible to ensure the work is original and that it does not infringe upon any copyright, proprietary or personal right of party.
6. Submitters are responsible to identify and sort out any potential conflicts of interest e.g., financial interest in products or processes described in the presentation materials, or membership on an advisory board or board of directors or other substantive relationships.
7. Submission of the online Registration and Abstract Submission form indicates the submitter has agreed to all the terms & conditions with regards to the conference registrations and abstract submissions as listed on the conference website.
